## **Instructions for 24/7 Prayer Assignment**

This prayer is to be totally Spirit-directed prayer as He directs.

No special topic.

The Holy Ghost gives the utterance the Lord wants. His eyes are going over the whole earth, seeking those He can get to utter His will, His plans, etc.

So, at the beginning of the 30 minute period, one turns oneself over to the Holy Spirit. Asking Him to direct the prayer as the Lord wants.

We keep our minds out of the way, so to speak. We suggest nothing. We pray "in the Spirit." i.e. "in tongues." However, if a known tongue slips in every now and then, as it will, it will be the Spirit's doing.

The point is that we are offering ourselves to the Lord to use our tongues and entire beings for Him to get spoken into the earth what He needs spoken.

## KJV

**Rom. 8:19** For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

**Rom. 8:22** For we know that the whole of Creation is groaning together in the pains of childbirth until this hour.

**Rom. 8:26** ¶ Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities (*infirmity-singular, the infirmity being when we know not what to pray as we ought*): for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself (Himself) maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

**Rom. 8:27** And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God.

## **God's Word Translation**

Rom. 8:26 ¶ At the same time the Spirit also helps us in our weakness,

because we don't know how to pray for what we need. But the Spirit intercedes along with our groans that cannot be expressed in words. **Rom. 8:27** The one who searches our hearts knows what the Spirit has in mind. The Spirit intercedes for God's people the way God wants him to.

## Weymouth

**Rom. 8:22** For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now.

**Rom. 8:23** And more than that, we ourselves, though we possess the Spirit as a foretaste and pledge of the glorious future, yet we ourselves inwardly sigh, as we wait and long for open recognition as sons through the deliverance of our bodies.

**Rom. 8:26** In the same way the Spirit also helps us in our weakness; for we do not know what prayers to offer nor in what way to offer them. But the Spirit Himself pleads for us in yearnings that can find no words, **Rom. 8:27** and the Searcher of hearts knows what the Spirit's meaning is, because His intercessions for God's people are in harmony with God's will.

The point here is when we do not know how to pray, or even what to pray for as we ought, but the Holy Spirit will use our vessels to pray God's will.

We know how to pray for many things.

And are instructed to do so in the Bible.

This is a 30 minute segment where we turn ourselves to Him.

One could begin by using these Scriptures. Or others. This passage has to do with end-of-days doings particularly.

We are not praying for, or even about, anything.

We turn ourselves over to Him.

Hook our tongues to our spirits, as the Word I read from Kenneth E. Hagin says to do.
